Section 1.01 Stallion Service Contract

(On Farm or Shipped Semen)

Jackies Gold Bee

AQHA # 3043849

I _____, herein after referred to as "Mare Owner", hereby request a reservation to the stallion JACKIES GOLD BEE, AQHA # 3043849 standing at CR Quarter Horses/ Cathy Reist herein referred to as CRQH.

Whereas, Mare Owner, owns/leases the Mare named _____ Reg. # _____ MARE OWNER wishes to breed said mare to the stallion during the _____ breeding season.

Breeding Fee

I agree to pay a breeding fee of \$ _____ to CRQH. This breeding fee includes a non-refundable booking/chute fee of \$ _____ with this contract. The balance of the breeding fee (_____) is due upon delivery of my mare to CRQH or prior to shipment of semen. Mare and /or foal care, veterinary and miscellaneous expenses will be paid before the mare leaves CRQH. I understand mare care will be \$5.00/day for wet or dry mares. All breeding fees are non-refundable under any conditions.

(a) Shipped Semen Fees

For shipped semen a fee of \$ _____ includes collection, evaluation and shipment of semen. This fee must be received before shipment. Checks require ten (10) days to clear. For your convenience, Master card and Visa are accepted through www. Paypal.com if you have an email account.

Refundable Deposit for Equitainer

A \$50 refundable deposit is required to insure prompt return of equitainer. CRQH agrees to refund total amount of said deposit to MARE OWNER upon return of equitainer without damage and all parts intact. If MARE OWNER any parts are missing, cost to replace parts will be deducted form the container deposit. A \$10 per day charge will be deducted from the deposit if said equitainer is not delivered to CRQH within 5 days (excluding Sunday) from the time the mare owner received Equitainer. If the Mare Owner provides CRQH with his/her own Equitainer, the \$50 deposit is not required.

Mare Requirements: (Prior to arriving at CRQH)

1. I represent that the mare to be bred is halter broken and in sound breeding condition.
2. A photocopy of the mare's registration papers must be furnished and returned with the contract. (both sides)
3. Mare must not be wearing shoes at CRQH unless approved by stallion owner.
4. I understand that for my own protection and that of the stallion and other horses present at CRQH my mare and/or foal must be current on worming and vaccinations before arriving at CRQH. (3-way, Rhino-flu, Strangles)

I expect that reasonable efforts will be made to settle the mare when present at CRQH. I understand that artificial insemination may be used in breeding my mare. The mare will be left until settled or returned as many times as necessary during the breeding season.

Shipped Semen Requirements:

1. All parties agree that only the mare designated in the contract will be inseminated with the shipped semen and that she will carry her own foal unless indicated that she will be part of an embryo transfer program. A Breeders Certificate will be issued following the birth of the foal, providing all bills have been paid
2. Mare Owner certifies that the designated veterinarian practices reproduction as a regular part of his/her practice and is available for palpation, cultures, AI and other necessary procedures, and has consented to oversee the breeding of said mare on a regular basis. Mare owner understands the veterinarian's credentials, as stated above, must be approved by the stallion owner/manager and that this Designated Veterinarian agrees to the following conditions:
 - a.) Will examine said mare within 45 days prior to semen shipment and certify in writing that the mare is free of infection and is in good breeding condition
 - b.) Will mail/fax written results of a uterine culture taken within 45 days of semen shipment to the stallion owner. Culture must be processed by a certified laboratory. First shipment of semen will not be sent unless a) and b) have been completed and sent to the Stallion Owner/Manager.

- c.) The provisions of a) and b) must be repeated for any mare failing to settle within two cycles after shipment of semen has commenced.
 - d.) Will examine said mare for pregnancy 16 to 18 days after insemination and again 35-55 days after insemination and mail/fax results to the stallion owner/manager.
 - e.) Failure to conform to the above will nullify all guarantees and no further semen will be shipped.
3. I understand that the burden of conception is placed almost entirely on me, the mare owner, and my veterinarian or technician. I understand that the mare must be bred immediately, on the same day semen is received by the designated veterinarian and proper methods of handling must be used.
 4. I understand that all requirements of applicable breed registries must be fully complied with. I will pay all costs of DNA testing of my mare and foal, registration fees, any permits or miscellaneous fees that are applicable. In the event of overseas shipments I will also pay all require tests and miscellaneous fees for the stallion.

I understand that the stallion has been DNA tested. The sperm count, motility/collection and packaging process meets or exceeds the industry standards. CRQH assumes responsibility only to ship enough extended semen (in viable condition at the time of collection) that the mare owner should receive at least 500 million progressively motile sperm within 24 hr delivery time.

REQUEST FOR SEMEN:

CRQH agrees to provide MARE OWNER semen when requested (per paragraph above "Shipped Semen Requirements"). Depending upon availability, at least two insemination doses will be provided. Semen shipments will be filled in the order they are received. Shipments will be insured to cover only equitainer replacement and collection fee costs. CRQH shall not be held liable for delays in the delivery of semen or semen that is lost in shipment or mishandled in any manner once it leaves the possession of CRQH.

1. I must get permission from stallion owner/manager prior to inducing heat cycles and coordinate all semen shipments in advance
2. CRQH Must be notified the day the mare comes in to heat.
3. CRQH must receive request for semen by 4 p.m. Mountain time the day prior to shipment.

PREGNANCY CHECK:

MARE OWNER agrees to have the mare examined by an early ultrasound scan between 14 and 18 days from the last day inseminated and again 35-55 days by designated Veterinarian and notify CRQH of her pregnancy status immediately by mail/email.

LIVE FOAL GUARANTEE:

If the mare does not settle or produce a "live foal" (one that stands and nurses or is hand fed for a period of 72 hours), CRQH agrees to rebreed the same mare or an approved substitute the following year on the terms and conditions provided in this contract without payment of any further breeding fee, but upon payment of mare care and/or foal care and a \$300 chute fee/handling fee and any other regular expenses. It is agreed that the provision will be of no further effect if the mare is taken to any other Stallion before returning to the above-named mare, and verifies the mares pregnancy loss, stillbirth, or newborn foals death by providing CRQH with an original, signed and dated veterinary certificate, on the veterinarian's own practice stationary.

REGISTRATION OF FOAL:

CRQH agrees to execute all necessary documents for the registration of the foal resulting from the breeding. CRQH will not be responsible for registration or DNA testing fees for the foal.

TERMINATION:

Either party may terminate this contract for failure of other party to meet any terms of the contract. In the case of any default by one party, the wronged party shall have the right to recover reasonable attorney's fees and court costs as a result of said default. If the Stallion should die, become unfit for service, be sold, or leased, MARE OWNER will be able to select another Stallion currently standing and owned/leased/managed by CRQH. If no substitute STALLION is available any breeding fee paid will be refunded. If MARE dies or becomes unfit to breed before producing a live foal, then MARE OWNER may substitute another MARE approved by CRQH.

CONTRACT IN FORCE:

When Cathy Reist signs, dates, and returns a copy of this contract to MARE OWNER, it will become the binding contract for both parties. This contract is not transferable or assignable by either party hereto without the expressed written consent of the other. In the event the MARE is sold or otherwise disposed of prior to the birth of the foal, the "Live Foal Guarantee" will no longer be valid unless specific written consent or assignment is given to MARE OWNER prior to transfer of ownership.
